A Member also questioned whether there were any financial implications involved in increased cancer wait times. Members asked how the number of those quitting smoking was recorded accurately. Members expressed concern that the target for the number of people aged 40-74 who have received a health check was not being met in either Berkshire East or Berkshire West and had been highlighted as red.
