SUMMARY OF REPORT

The report sets out the draft work programme for the Standards Committee for the 23014/15 municipal year together with clarification of the role and remit of the Committee.

Background

The Standards Committee has the following roles and functions:-

- a) promoting and maintaining high standards of conduct by Councillors, co-opted members, including church and parent governor representatives;
- b) assisting the Councillors, co-opted members, including church and parent governor representatives, to observe the Members' Code of Conduct;
- c) advising the Council on the adoption or revision of its Members' Code of Conduct;
- monitoring the operation of the Members' Code of Conduct, the Officers' Code of Conduct and the Council's Whistleblowing policy and any other appropriate codes of conduct and procedures;
- e) advising, training or arranging to train Councillors, co-opted members and church and parent governor representatives on matters relating to the Members' Code of Conduct;
- f) the exercise of (a) to (e) above in relation to the parish/town councils wholly or mainly in its area and the members of those parish/town councils;
- g) the presentation of an annual report by the Chairman of the Standards Committee to Council.

Draft Work Programme 2014/15

The Standards Committee may review any matter relating to the above scope. The Committee is scheduled to meet four times in 2014/15. With such a relatively broad remit one of the biggest challenges for the Committee, in deciding its work programme for the new municipal year, will be prioritising items for consideration.

When looking at potential items for its work programme, the Committee should consider to what extent it will have an impact on residents; whether it is a widespread issue (e.g. affecting more than one ward) and what value the Standards Committee can add by looking at the item. The limited support resources available should also be taken into account.

A Draft Work Programme for 2014/15 has been produced (Appendix A) for the Committee to consider. Members should decide whether there are any additional items which they feel should be programmed.

The work programme is an evolving document and items can be added or removed should matters of higher priority emerge.
