REPORT OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CORPORATE SERVICES OVERVIEW AND SCRUTINY COMMITTEE

A meeting of the committee was held on 22 June. At that meeting we considered the programme for the year including the items referred by OSMC. Of the latter, the committee decided to include in the programme an assessment and review of the potential impact of the Government's right to buy scheme. The details of this scheme are not yet agreed so we have added the review to the agenda for the November meeting in the hope that details are available by then. If not the review may have to be rescheduled. The item on possible income generation possibilities from the Crossrail project has not yet been incorporated into the meeting schedule.

The task and finish group on parking near railway stations had it's first meeting. It was agreed to hold the next meeting in the Autumn at which the list of potential witnesses and lines of questioning would be compiled.
