Community Service Provision by Health Harmonie

Health Harmonie provide the Community Ophthalmology Service in Berkshire West.

They provide services from three locations including: University Medical Centre, Reading, West Berkshire Community Hospital and Woosehill Medical Centre, Wokingham.


The Services Provided by Health Harmonie are for Management of Minor Eye Conditions and Minor Eye Surgery . Listed below are some examples of conditions they manage:

- Dry Eyes;
- ▶ Cysts;
- ▶ Common Eyelid abnormalities;
- ▶ Conjunctivitis;
- ▶ Pupil abnormalities;
- ▶ Inflamed Eyelids;
- ▶ Allergies;
- ▶ Small dots, circles and specks in a persons vision;
- ▶ Eczema around the eye;
- ▶ Inflammation of the middle area of the eye;
- ▶ Ocular Refinement;
- ▶ Repair of the eyelid.
- ▶ Removal of foreign object from eye (as appropriate)

Secondary Care Hospital Services

The services provided by Secondary Care include surgery on the day, inpatient procedures, outpatient eye services and Eye Casualty. Royal Berkshire Hospital provide the majority of these services in Berkshire West

Services provided include:

 - Cataract Removal;
 - Management of Glaucoma;
 - Management of Age-Macular Disease;
 - Eye Injection Services;
 - Children Eye Services;
 - Eye Surgery Services (More complex than those treated in the community service);
 - Management of conditions at the back of eyes
