** Polehampton Junior School has agreed to allocate above their admission number as an exception as it was considered that it would be unreasonable not to allocate so as to ensure as smooth a transition as possible from infant to junior, reflecting the schools' principle of the 2 schools being linked, and therefore providing a 4-11 learning journey through the Polehampton Federation. It is the local authority intention to reduce the number back to 60 in line with the net capacity of the school.												
*** It was agreed by the governing body to allocate a further 27 pupils to create sufficient places in the borough as part of a permanent expansion of the school.												
**** The resource has three places within the admission number, two places are allocated, the third is to be allocated by the Special Educational Needs Team in accordance with a review of individual pupil assessments.
