Environmental Health objects to this application for the following reasons;

- In August 2014 a music event was held on the same site (under the guise of a family festival) and resulted in over 80 complaints about excess noise from residents near and far. Conditions applied to the TEN were ignored and Abatement Notices were subsequently served on the organiser and the landowners.
- On Monday 21st February 2022, I spoke to Tom Sewell who agreed to come back to me with details of the planned event, I have received nothing so far and had no response to subsequent emails. This lack of engagement leads me to formalise my objection.
