Priority	Update
Recruitment of volunteers	We have five members of our Advisory Group and are continuing to recruit to this and other roles within Healthwatch Wokingham Borough, who have met regularly and have taking up the roles by attending events and lead in projects
GP Access Survey	Next 3 months (Oct to Dec) the team are undertaking a feedback roadshow on public awareness about the new way of working in GP practice and the NHS app. Enclosed are the venues and dates of the focus groups :- https://www.healthwatchwokingham.co.uk/post/healthwatch-launch-gp-services-project-in-wokingham-reading-and-west-berkshire . We plan to do the focus groups face to face as well as online in the evening to enable as many people as possible to participate.
