Dear Rebecca,

I understand that Henley Festival are making an application for an Order under Section 16A Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the diversion of Footpath Number 4 Remenham during the following hours in 2016:-

STAGE BUILD - short diversion taking walkers approximately 10 m off the towpath for a length of approximately 80 m around fenced off stage construction site:

Monday, 4th July 00:01 to Wednesday, 6th July 17:45

I understand that Henley Festival will make every effort to re-open the towpath sooner, as long as it is safe to do so.

SHOW NIGHTS - full diversion as applied for, and granted over recent years, taking walkers along the maintained road at the rear of the site:

Wednesday, 6 th July	- 17:45 to midnight
Thursday, 7 th July	- 17:45 to midnight
Friday, 8 th July	- 17:45 to 01:00
Saturday, 9 th July	- 17:45 to 02:00
Sunday, 10 th July	- 17:45 to 23:30

STAGE DE-RIG - short diversion taking walkers approximately 10 m off the towpath for a length of approximately 80 m around the fenced off stage construction site:

Monday, 11th July 06:00 to Tuesday, 12th July 23:59


I understand Henley Festival will make every effort to re-open the towpath sooner, as long as it is safe to do so.

Should Wokingham Borough Council decide to make the Order, we, as freeholders of the land, confirm that the alternative route, as detailed, will be made available and kept open for the use of members of the public during the time that the Footpath is diverted.

I am quite sure that the short diversion proposed makes a significant contribution to ensuring the health and safety of those using the footpath whilst the stage is being erected and dismantled.
