#### **Guidance for Town and Parish Councils**

## Guidance for filling in your Members Interest Form

This guidance should help you fill in your Members Interest Form, which is required by both the Localism Act 2011, and also your Code of Conduct. There are two parts to the form: Part 1, which deals with your Disclosable Pecuniary Interests. These types of interest are statutory, and have criminal sanctions attached to them if you do not declare them in this form. Part 2 deals with interests that are required by your Code of Conduct. You may be in breach of your Code of Conduct if you do not declare these types of interest, but there are no criminal sanctions attached to them.

Your Members Interests form will be available for public inspection and will be published on Wokingham Borough Council's website. If you consider that disclosure of the details of a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest could lead to you, or a person connected with you, being subject to violence or intimidation, and the Town/Parish clerk agrees, then the specifics of that interest can be excluded. You will however need to state this interest in broad terms on your form. Please contact your Town/Parish clerk if you are concerned about one of your interests.

Please note that there is separate important guidance for circumstances when you should declare any interests that you have in a meeting. Please ask the Town/Parish clerk if you have not seen this guidance.

# Part 1: Disclosable Pecuniary Interests (statutory requirement)

A 'Disclosable Pecuniary Interest' will relate to you or your partner. A "partner" means a spouse or civil partner, a person with whom you are living as husband or wife, or a person with whom you are living as if you are civil partners. The full statutory list is shown on the form.

Within 28 days of becoming a Member or co-opted member, you must, by law, notify your Town/Parish clerk of any 'Disclosable Pecuniary Interests'. Please note it is equally important to notify your Town/Parish clerk of any changes to your Disclosable Pecuniary Interests within 28 days of your knowledge of the change. Failure to do so carries a criminal sanction.

An explanation of the various headings contained in the Members' Interest Form is listed below:

Employment, office, trade profession or vocation: The key here is that anything that you do for profit or gain must be included in this section of the form. If you are employed, you must state the name of your employer. If you are self employed, please state that in this section. If you are a Director, and you receive remuneration for doing so, this should be stated here. If you are not employed, for example if you are retired, you can leave this part of the form blank.

<u>Sponsorship:</u> This covers circumstances where you receive payment or other financial benefit from anyone other than your Town/Parish Council in respect of expenses incurred by carrying out your duties as a Member. It also covers your election expenses, and any financial benefit that you obtain from a Trade Union. Receipt of payment must have been made during the period of 12 months ending with the day that you gave notification of this interest. (see 28 day period above).

Contracts: This section asks you to list any contract which:

- you or your partner personally have with your Town/Parish Council, AND/OR
- where either of you or your partner are members of a body, or directors of a company which has a contract with your Town/Parish Council. You will also have to list a contract here where you or your partner own Securities in that body or bodies (see explanation of 'Securities' below)

This section only asks you to list those contracts where goods or services are to be provided, or works executed AND which are not fully discharged, that is, the contract is still ongoing.

<u>Land</u>: Any land within Wokingham Borough which you and/or your partner own must be listed here. **This includes your home.** You do not have to list any land which you own which is situated outside Wokingham Borough.

<u>Licences</u>: This only refers to land over which you have an informal right to occupy. If you have a formal lease or tenancy, this should be listed under 'Land'. Normally this kind of land ownership is temporary, or it may relate to a right of way over someone's land.

<u>Securities</u>: This Disclosable Pecuniary Interest refers to securities/shares which you own in a company where the place of business or land is within your Town/Parish Council. The total nominal value of your securities must exceed £25,000 OR amount to one hundredth of the total issued shared capital. It goes on to say that you must also register the security if the share capital is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which you or your partner holds exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class.

"Securities" can also mean shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stocks, and bonds, units of a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description, other than money deposited with a building society..

# Part 2: Other Personal Interests (required by the Member Code of Conduct)

There are no criminal sanctions attached to this second group of interests, but failure to declare them may incur a risk of being in breach of the Member Code of Conduct.

An explanation of these interests is as follows:

Membership of Other Bodies: This is fairly self explanatory. It asks you to list any membership of a body in which you have general control or management AND to which you have been appointed or nominated by your Town/Parish Council. A 'body' in this sense means a group whose members who have a common aim or theme.

Membership of any body exercising functions of a public nature/charity/influence of public opinion or policy:

The first part of this section under a) asks you to list any body exercising functions of a public nature.

The next part, b), asks you to list charities of which you are a member. Members who are Freemasons only need to list this if their Lodge is a charity. Normally they would only need to do so if they are members of the Grand Charity.

The last part of this section c), refers only to membership of bodies whose principal purposes include the influence of public opinion or policy AND where your membership of that body is one which puts you in a position of general control or management.



# Changes to Registration of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests, Pecuniary Interests and Personal Interests and Disclosure of Gifts and Hospitality.

Notification of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests, pecuniary interests, personal interests and disclosure of gifts and hospitality.

I understand that I must, within 28 days of becoming a member or co-opted member, notify the Town/Parish clerk of any 'Disclosable Pecuniary Interests', pecuniary interests, personal interests and disclosure of gifts and hospitality, including any changes to sensitive information and provide written notification of that change.

I recognise and understand that it is a criminal offence to:

- Fail to notify the Town/Parish clerk of any Disclosable Pecuniary Interest within 28 days of election
- Fail to disclose a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest at a meeting if it is not on the register
- Fail to notify the Town/Parish clerk within 28 days of a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest that is not on the register that you have disclosed to a meeting
- Participate in any discussion or vote on a matter in which you have a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest
- As an executive member discharging a function acting alone, and having a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest in such a matter, failing to notify the Town/Parish clerk within 28 days of the interest.
- Knowingly or recklessly providing information that is false or misleading in notifying the Town/Parish clerk of a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest or in disclosing such interest to a meeting

and that any breach of these regulations in the above terms can be referred to the Police and or the Director of Public Prosecutions for criminal proceedings.
